Signature****HB1295**

On Wednesday June 17 the Life Equality Act, HB 1295, passed the Mississippi Senate and was returned to the House for concurrence. On Tuesday June 23, the House voted to send the bill to the Governor's desk where it awaits his signature. The Act would prohibit abortions performed on the basis of race, sex, or genetic abnormality, except in medical emergencies.

"Pro-Life Mississippi strongly supports the Life Equality Act," said PLM President Laura Duran. "No Mississippi child should have to pass a genetic test to earn the right to be born."
