Church Updates

The church members had discipleship classes where they were taken through the nine marks of a healthy church member. The lessons learned included what evangelism is, why believers are called to share the good news, and the role of a local church in evangelism.

5 members gave their lives to Christ; 9 members from the community joined the church; the church received 16 visitors, 4 from America, 4 from Kampala, and 8 from the community.



Prison Ministry

The inmates at Luzira prison have been undertaking discipleship classes based on the theme 'Nine Marks Of A Healthy Church Member'. They learned about the gospel and were encouraged to apply it. 13 members gave their lives to Christ!

Plans are ongoing for a Baptism ceremony which will be held after the discipleship classes.
