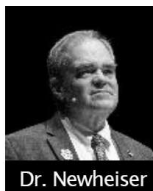

Pastor Josué Jiménez, SRL site coordinator in Spring Valley, NY, recently returned from teaching in Cochabamba, Bolivia. For the last 26 years, SRL has taken the Reformation to LATAM. Pastor Jimenez shared, "Today, the Reformation is more alive than ever. Over sixty attended each class session. The hunger for Sacred Scripture was evident. They eagerly immersed in my history course, The First Five Centuries of Ancient Catholic (universal) Christian Church—which is not Roman Catholic."

VENEZUELA FIELD UPDATE

Professor Dr. Alexander Mercado, after teaching in Venezuela, writes, "It is clear that the Lord is at work in this beautiful country. Sound, Reformed teaching of the Word of God in Venezuela has impacted many. I am impressed by the maturity in faith—the growth in pastoral ministry—that these students have reached in such a relatively short time. They have become true examples of love for Christ, possessing both a zeal for God and His Word. Their determination is to see a Venezuela that reflects more and more the glory of God."
